Could benefit from cropping the left side more and focusing the viewer on the right side trains ~ 1st Place - Perfect entry for this competition as this image demonstrates artistry through the use of tone, composition, and captured beauty. The maker chose to desaturate most of the color from the image, leaving it almost without color. This is an interesting application and allowing the viewer to spend more time studying the play on lights, darks, reflections and movement in the image.

Judges Comments: Good exposure, longer exposure for water effect. Not sure what the subject is. ~ Nice long exposure ~ This is an image of a stream taken to create a smooth texture in the water. The warm tones in the image and detail in the rocks are attractive. The maker may consider trying an alternate crop that excludes some of the twigs and branches on the river bank. The white water also seems to be overexposed and has lost its detail.

Suggest trying different angles to get more perspective ~ This is a nice image of a bee on a vibrant yellow colored flower. The bee detail is sharp highlighting the finest details such as the hair on the bees legs. The maker could experiment with a tighter crop that really highlights the bee and allows the flower to fade into the background. Nice capture.

The foliage in the vase is underwhelming ~ This is a still life image of a dried flower arrangement. The color palette is complimentary and pleasing. I would recommend the photographer experiment with alternative crops for this image. Ideally the crop will draw the viewers attention into the image with a clear focus on the floral arrangement, eliminating the light, competing textures, multiple angles and lines and colors of the ceiling and adjacent wall.

Interesting angle Nice color and textures that were captured. Good focus for the angled shot. Not sure what element on the wall painting is your focal point...I want to see more of the peace sign, but not sure what else that would have included.

On overcast days (as in the image) the colors become even more saturated- which I do not see in this image. Lots of great colors -- could make them pop even more with some post-processing. Just the right amount of sky and foreground water for balance (too bad you were not blessed with great clouds on this day). I like timing of the little boat coming at you. Focus could be a bit better.
